POSSIBLE Interventions/consequences for unacceptable work

- 8th period or Friday school to finish or redo assignment or part of assignment.
- Ineligibility for school activities until the work is acceptable.
- Alternative task to replace the unacceptable work.
- Unit Exam scores less than 70% will receive 8th period or Friday school for *REQUIRED corrections within 1 week of the exam date.*
See test correction policy for point values available for specific scores.
Failure to complete this required task will result in matrix consequences.
- Assignment log/notebook signed by parents
- Matrix offense for "failure to pursue a course of study"

GURANTEED BENEFITS OF ACCEPTABLE WORK ON TIME

- More time to complete other tasks
- More personal time to spend on other activities
- Better relations with parental units
- Higher GPA's leading to better chances for scholarships
- More flexibility in upper-class schedule
