Leslie Walborn added, that the work that took place this summer really helped them to be ready for the module process. She sees the students asking questions, looking up answers on their own, and being more independent.

The Community School has launched its first two classes this month; they are Zumba and Group Power. Travis Reeser reports that we have had a very good turnout for both. Community surveys were sent out and are now being returned. These will help us to know what the community would like to see in the Community School. We are looking into using the Nazarene Church activity building for a 70's and older exercise class and also a cardio fitness class. In October we will be offering two more classes to include an adult Spanish class and an adult computer class. Future classes or seminars that have been discussed are a children's gymnastics class and a couponing class.
